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# Severe weather continues

MEXICO CITY- The National Meteorological Service (SMN) warns residents of Chihuahua, Coahuila, Durango, Nuevo Leon, Zacatecas and San Luis Potosi of severe winter weather conditions that will hit on Thursday.

The SMN said that the cold front will arrive via the northeast of the country, bringing the fourth winter storm of the season. The front will cause a drop in temperature, strong winds and snowfall throughout a large area of the Mesa del Norte until Jan. 16.

The organization specified that the cold front will be associated with strong downpours, therefore they recommend residents of the six states to stay alert to the different reports and forecasts issued by SMN.

From Thursday the SMN forecasts snow or sleet in the mountain areas of these states, as well as temperatures below zero in Chihuahua, Coahuila, Durango, Hidalgo, State of Mexico, Nuevo Leon, Sonora and Zacatecas.

Cold weather is also expected between 0 and 5 degrees Celsius in Aguascalientes, the Federal District, Guanajuato, Jalisco, Michoacan, Oaxaca, Puebla, Queretaro, San Luis Potosi, Sinaloa, Tamaulipas, Tlaxcala and Veracruz.

The SMN expects Thursday's cold front to be moderate to weak in the Isthmus and Gulf of Tehuantepec in Oaxaca.



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
